## **Key Information**

## **Our learning in Year Four**

<u>Maths:</u> This half term we have begun exploring Measurement. We will be learning to add and subtract length and measure perimeter. Following this we will begin Multiplication and Division. We will be multiplying and dividing by 10 and 100. We will then be exploring multiplication and corresponding division facts for the remaining times tables.

**English:** This half term we will be developing our knowledge of fictional texts. We will read **Wombat Goes Walkabout** and become familiar with a variety of animals from Australia. We will then look at the characteristics of British animals and create our own version of the text but based within Britain.

### **Other Curriculum Areas**

In **History** we will be focusing on the Romans. We will be studying the impact they had upon the world and their invasion of Britain.

In **Science** we are about to begin our 'States of Matter' topic where we explore the features of gas, solids and liquids. The year 4 children will be exploring the process of evaporation and conducting experiments investigating how materials and objects change from solids into liquids and liquids into solids Throughout this topic the children will be investigating the process of evaporation and condensation using practical examples.

In French we will continue to extend our vocabulary and become confident in our conversational french.

In **R.E.** our work focuses on Reconciliation. We will be considering how to be a good Samaritan and think of others first. We will be looking at the parable of the Prodigal Son and considering the need to be contrite using the story of Zacchaeus as a way to see how we can start again. Later in the term we will celebrate the season of Advent and prepare for the very special celebration of the birth of Christ.

In **Music** we are exploring rhythm and pulse, beats in a bar and recognising time signatures. We will also be preparing for the season of Advent learning new hymns and songs to celebrate this time.

In our first **R.S.H.E** module, we will be learning how to stay healthy and look after our bodies. We will also look at the different sacraments within the Church. In **Class Reading**, we are continuing to read Danny Champion of the World (CG/LC) and Charlotte's Web (CR).)
