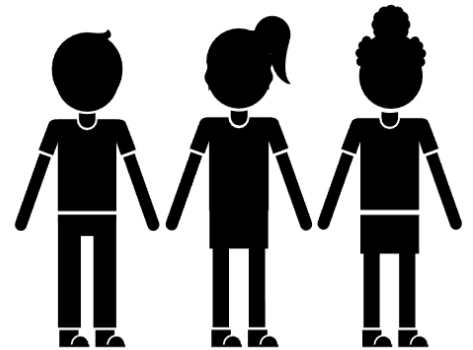


Art Ambassadors
