#### **Class newsletters**

Year group letters will be sent out next week. They will include dates for the curriculum cafes where you are able to come into school and meet the class teacher and find out about the curriculum for the year group.

We are going to trial the children wearing their PE kits for school on PE days. The rationale behind this is to allow children to have longer PE sessions rather than spending time getting changed and it is often difficult finding spaces for the children to get changed, in addition, it will mean that you do not have to purchase extra trainers for school or send them back and forth.

PE days will remain the same per half term and we will inform you of any changes. There may be times when uniform is needed on a PE day, e.g. whole school Mass, school photos, but we will inform you of this in advance.

Please remember that St. Aloysius, PE hoodies are for PE days only- school jumpers or cardigans can also be worn on PE days along with shorts, leggings or tracksuit bottoms (no sports logos please).

Classes from Y1-Y6 will now have two PE sessions a week and PE kits will be sent back home so that you have them ready. I have been informed that our uniform stockists will have more hoodies and tracksuits coming in.
