We ask that children wear an item of clothing with a number or shapes on- to clarify it is non-school uniform day for all children.




Language Day

There will be some fun activities throughout the day. We ask for £1 donation per child to help raise funds for the charity. This can be paid via ParentPay.




Reminder- Kindness Cafe
