## **Summer Fayre**

The fayre will be set up on the field on the junior site.

The fayre will begin at 1:30pm; if you or a family member would like to take the children around the fayre then they can be collected between 1pm-1:15pm. Please then wait on the junior yard until we open the field gates.

We know that it is difficult to arrange childcare when we have events during the day, which is why we want to reassure you that if you cannot collect your child early, we will keep the children and they will be taken to the fayre in groups so that they still experience the fun. If possible, please send them with some change to spend on the stalls. They will be based in the year 6 classroom (first room near the door on the junior yard) to be collected when an adult can get to school.

Year 6 children will be helping to serve behind the stalls, so do not need to be collected, but will still get plenty of time for fun.

Please bring change where possible, and bring picnic chairs or blankets if you wish.

#### **Sun Cream**

Please apply sun cream to your child before they arrive at school each morning. In addition, we ask that you send in a named bottle of sun cream that can be kept in school for reapplication during the day. If you are unable to label it yourself, we are happy to provide name stickers. These bottles will be passed on to your child's new class in September and will be used if needed as the weather is sometimes hot when we return. They will be returned when the weather turns colder.

Please note: due to allergy concerns, we are unable to provide school sun cream.

On particularly hot days, children will be given time to top up their sun cream once during the school day. We expect that children will apply their own sun cream; however, staff will supervise and assist younger children as needed. For ease of use, roll-on or spray sun cream is recommended.

## St. Aloysius Feast Day Celebration


Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June - collection 12:30pm

The annual St. Aloysius Feast Day picnic is nearly with us. Following feedback from staff about this wonderful day, we are hosting it slightly earlier than previous years. The reasoning behind this is that the children are fed lunch (which many do not eat on this day) and then a picnic. To save food wastage, the children will be able to eat their lunch on the field once collected. No hot dinners will be served on this day and children will receive a school packed lunch to take on the field at 12:30pm.

Again, do not worry if you cannot collect your children as we will supervise the children on a section of the field so that they still get to enjoy the day.

## Wizard of Oz


We are selling tickets to the Year 6 families for £3 each. Initially, we will allocate two tickets per child and then release more when we know how the sales are going.
