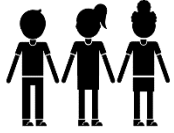
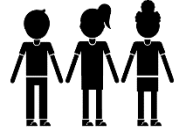


Love in Action

Who Are They?

Our **Love in Action** group are a group of infant children linked to **Mini Vinnies**. It is a simplified, age-appropriate version of the work done by St Vincent de Paul Society groups in schools. It focuses on helping very young children understand kindness, empathy, and service through simple actions.



What They Do?

- Help people in need

Our infant children *show love through what they do*, this develops into deeper conversations as and when the children are ready.



How They Make A Difference?

They practice everyday kindness:

- Sharing toys and materials
- Helping classmates who feel sad or stuck
- Using polite, caring words

Even at a young age, they:

- Say simple prayers for others
- Take part in quiet reflection time
- Think about how they can help people

They take part in small, guided actions:

- Collecting food or clothes for those in need
- Participating in simple fundraising (e.g., bake sales)
- Helping care for the school or local environment

They try to:

- Show good behaviour in class and playground
- Encourage others to be kind
- Demonstrate respect and fairness
